2024 AEIRS Annual Meeting Poster Presentation Guidelines

Poster presentations will be shared on large monitors during the July $17^{\rm th}$ Welcome Reception where presenters can interact with conference attendees and answer questions. The poster presentations will not be orally presented.

General Guidelines:

- Posters should be created electronically using Microsoft PowerPoint
 - o To set slide dimensions, follow the steps outlined in **Change the size of your slides.**
- Posters should be well laid out, visually appealing, and professional, including the presenter's names, credentials, and sponsoring institution.
- Posters should guide conference attendees through the study's purpose, methodology, results, and discussion yet must be concise. Follow your institution's template as appropriate.
- Presenters are encouraged to include a QR code for conference attendees' access to supplemental material, if applicable.
- Presenters are responsible for obtaining permission to use copyrighted material, and it must be referenced accordingly.
- Poster file should be saved as a .pdf document.
- Presenters will engage with conference attendees and answer questions during the Welcome Reception
